



## 2<sup>nd</sup> ERSO Show Contest in Prague, Czech Republic

18.11.16 - 20.11.16

The Czech Rope Skipping Association is pleased to be the host of the 2<sup>nd</sup> ERSO Show Contest, which will be held on November 19<sup>th</sup> in the beautiful city of Prague.

### The Host City: Prague



Prague, with 1.26 million inhabitants, is the capital and largest city in the Czech Republic and has been a political, cultural and economic centre of central Europe with waxing and waning fortunes during its 1,100-year existence.

The city is situated on the Vltava (Moldau) River and is home to a number of famous cultural attractions, many of which survived the violence and destruction of 20th-century Europe. Main attractions include the Prague Castle, the Charles Bridge, Old Town Square with the Prague astronomical clock, the Jewish Quarter, Petřín hill and Vyšehrad.

Since 1992, the extensive historic centre of Prague has been included in the UNESCO list of World Heritage Sites.

Its rich history makes it a popular tourist destination, and the city receives more than 6.4 million international visitors annually, as of 2014. Prague is the fifth most visited European city after London, Paris, Istanbul and Rome.

### Travelling to Prague

Prague is served by Václav Havel Airport, the biggest airport in the Czech Republic and one of the biggest airports in central and eastern Europe. It is the hub of the flag carrier, Czech Airlines as well as of the low-cost airlines SmartWings and Wizz Air operating throughout Europe.

Guests will be met at the airport, provided with tickets and then travel by public transport (Bus No. 119 followed by Tram No. 26) to the hotel in the city center. Guests arriving by road travel directly to the Belvedere Hotel, Milady Horákové 19, Prague 7, 170 00. Parking is very limited beside the hotel, but available nearby.

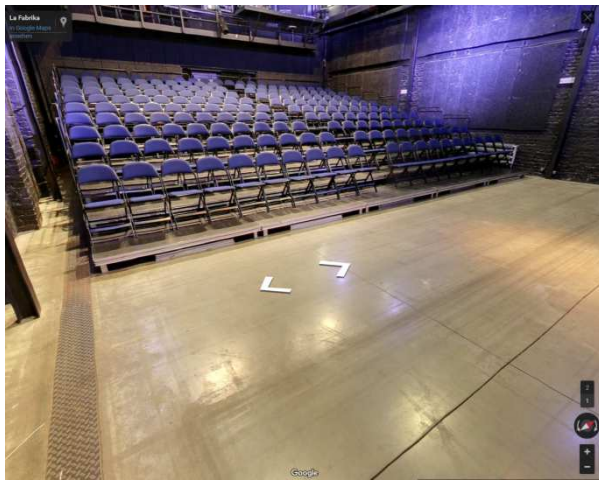
All guests will be given two 24 hour public transport tickets to enable them to travel in Prague as they wish before and after the Show Contest.

### The Show Contest: The facts

- Up to 5 teams per country may compete
- Each team consists of 4 to 6 skippers
- The skippers must be born in 2004 or before
- Maximum of 4 minutes per show
- Music is compulsory
- Two types of judging (see ERSO Show Contest Rules)

### The Event Venue: “La Fabrika”

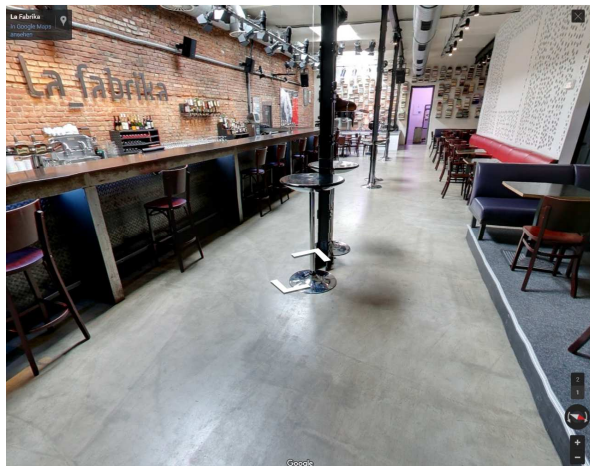
This unique complex located in the area between the Delnicka, Komunardu and Pristavni streets, was recently created by converting several old factory buildings, dating back to the beginning of the 20th century, into a modern multimedia studio venue. It’s the industrial origins that give La Fabrika its specific charm and unique appearance.



Studio 1 “The Theatre”

The stage area measures 10 m depth and 8 m width with full height with an additional 1 m on each side above which loudspeakers are mounted approximately 3m above the floor. The spectator area has a capacity of 240 seats set in 12 teared rows of 20 seats.

Video projection of the Studio 1 stage area will be provided in Studio 2 beside the warm up area, to enable the participants to follow the other shows before and after their own performance.

## The Hotel

The hotel Belvedere is very comfortable (four stars), conveniently situated close to the theatre, close to the city center and a 3 minute walk from the Letna Park, which overlooks the Vltava (Moldau) River and the city center and stretches until Prague Castle. Nicely furnished double and triple rooms will be available, each with a bath/shower room.

An evening meal on the Friday and breakfast on the Saturday and Sunday will be served in the hotel dining room. Lunch and dinner will be provided on the Saturday at La Fabrika and on the Sunday a snack lunch will be provided at the gym.

## Workshop

On the Sunday morning a Rope Skipping Workshop will be held in the Tyršův dům gym, the oldest and most famous gym in Prague with a special atmosphere. During the afternoon, 4 full size trampolines will be available each with instructors, for those who wish to try their skills in this sport.

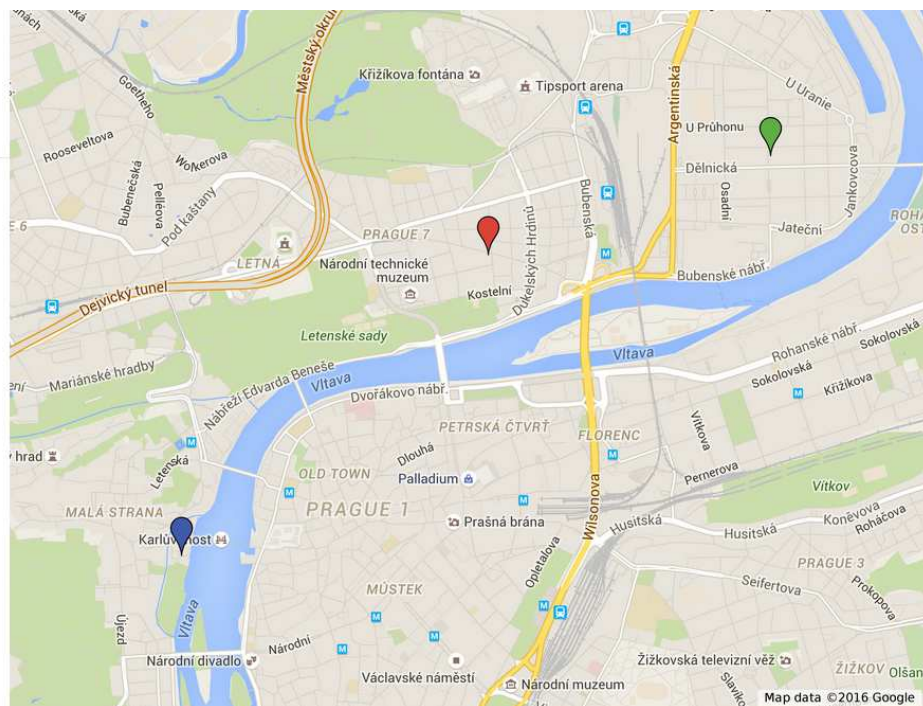
